Interchangeable pilot keeps cutter properly aligned. Purchase extra pilots to use one cutter for many different calibers. Pilots for other calibers available separately.

Safety Instruction Guide for BRASS ONE CALIBER SET

Introduction

- Choose the appropriate pilot for your caliber. The pilots for other calibers are available separately.
- Insert the pilot into the bore of the firearm to ensure proper fit.

4. Using the Facing Cutter

- Position the muzzle of the firearm against the cutter.
- Rotate the handle gently to square the muzzle after shortening or repair.
- Check frequently to ensure the muzzle is being squared evenly.

5. Using the Chamfer Cutter

- Position the chamfer cutter at the edge of the rifling or revolver cylinder mouth.
- Rotate the handle to break the edges of the rifling for a clean bullet exit or to chamfer the cylinder mouth.
- Use a light touch to avoid removing too much material.

6. Finishing Up

- After use, clean any debris from the cutters and pilots.
- Store the BRASS ONE CALIBER SET in its polypropylene box to keep it organized and protected.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any damaged or wornout components in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste. Check with local waste management authorities for proper disposal methods.
