Locking bar system has interchangeable locating keys for mounting to MIL-STD 1913 Picatinny, Glock-style, S&W 99, S&W TSW, and Beretta 90-Two accessory rails. Fits all holsters designed to accept pistols mounted with the earlier Streamlight M-3/-5/-6 series lights. Streamlight TLR Contour Remote available separately.

- To turn on the light, press the paddle switch. The light can be set to momentary or constant mode.
- For the TLR1s model, activate the strobe setting by quickly tapping the paddle switch twice.
- Adjust the light's position as needed to ensure optimal illumination of your target area.

### 3. Battery Replacement:

- When the light begins to dim, replace the two CR123 lithium batteries.
- Ensure the batteries are installed with the correct polarity, as indicated inside the battery compartment.
