TLR1 HL Weaponlight Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the TLR1 HL Weaponlight with Dual Remote Kit. This guide provides essential safety instructions and usage information to ensure the safe and effective operation of your product. Please read this guide carefully before use.

1. To activate the weaponlight, press the ambidextrous momentary switch. For steady on, press the switch fully.

2. To enable or disable the userprogrammable strobe feature, refer to the specific programming instructions in the product manual.
3. Regularly check the battery level and replace batteries as needed. Use only two 3volt CR123 lithium batteries.
4. After use, turn off the weaponlight to conserve battery life.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the weaponlight and batteries in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire or with household waste.
- Check local guidelines for recycling options for electronic devices.
