Introduction

 - Type 1 – 223 Remington Based Cartridges
 - Type 2 – Valkyrie Based Cartridges
 - Type 3 – PPC, Grendel, SPC Based Cartridges
 - Type 4 – Short Action 308 Winchester & Creedmoor Based Cartridges
 - Type 4 XL – Long Action 308 Win & 3006 Based Cartridges
 - Type 5 – 284 Winchester Based Cartridges
 - Type 6 – Short Action PRC Based Cartridges
 - Type 6 XL – Long Action PRC, Belted & Weatherby Magnum Based Cartridges
 - Type 7 – SAUM Based Cartridges
 - Type 7 XL – Nosler and RUM Based Cartridges
 - Type 8 – WSM Based Cartridges
 - Type 9 – Lapua and Norma Magnum based Cartridges
- Ensure that the Arbor style press is in good working condition before use.
- Follow all manufacturer instructions for the Arbor press and die inserts.
- Do not force the die inserts into the Arbor press; they should fit securely without excessive force.
- Always keep your hands and body clear of the die inserts and press during operation to avoid injury.
- Use the appropriate bullet seating stems for the bullet type being used.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Preparation:

- Gather all necessary equipment, including the Arbor press, die inserts, bullet seating stems, and cartridges.
- Ensure your workspace is clean and free of any obstructions.

2. Installation:

- Select the appropriate Cartridge Base Insert for your specific cartridge type.
