Instructions for Installation and Usage

• Installation:

1. Ensure the Glock® 17 is pointed in a safe direction and is unloaded.
2. Insert the magazine into the magazine well until it clicks into place.
3. To remove, press the magazine release button and pull the magazine out of the well.

• Usage:

1. Load the magazine by pressing down on the follower and inserting rounds from the rear.
2. Ensure that the rounds are seated properly and that the magazine is fully loaded.
3. Insert the loaded magazine into the firearm as described in the installation instructions.
4. After use, remove the magazine and unload all rounds in a safe manner.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine according to local regulations regarding firearms and ammunition disposal.
- Do not dispose of the magazine in regular household waste.
- If the magazine is damaged or no longer usable, consider returning it to the manufacturer for proper disposal.
