Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 RECON BARREL 5.56

Introduction

 - Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
 - Be aware of your surroundings and ensure a safe backstop.
- After use, clean the barrel according to the manufacturer's recommendations to maintain performance and longevity.

- Do not throw the barrel in regular trash; instead, contact local waste management authorities for proper disposal methods.
