The Dillon XL750 is a high-speed progressive reloading machine designed to load common rifle and handgun cartridges, from 17 Hornet through the common belted magnum cartridges in rifle, and 32 ACP through 500 S&W in handgun. Machine height from the bench is 32" without the optional electric case feeder, 38 1/2" with the electric casefeeder installed. A die set has to be ordered separately. Other options shown, but not included: Casefeeder, Strong Mount, Bullet Tray, Powdercheck Die and Low Powder Sensor.

Safety Instructions

Introduction

- Monitor the reloading process closely, ensuring that all components are functioning correctly.

- If you notice any irregularities, stop the machine and investigate the issue.

4. PostUse Care

- Clean the machine after each use to prevent buildup of powder residue.
- Store the machine and all components in a safe, dry place when not in use.

- Dispose of any unused or expired reloading components in accordance with local regulations.
- Follow proper hazardous waste disposal guidelines for primers and powders.
